

From Pastor Carl's Desk

“A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.”

John 13:34-35

Last week in my sermon, I mentioned the importance of having people with whom you can share your life, people with whom you can really share how you are doing. That is why our small group ministry is so important. It is important to have brothers and sisters in Christ with whom we can share both our joys and sorrows.

That is one of the main premises behind our revamped small group ministry. Let me tell what has changed. First, is the name. We are no longer calling our small groups “Neighborhood Small Groups.” Rather, we are calling them “Life Groups” because it is our hope that people in each group will in many ways live life together. The second change is the groups will no longer be location based but rather affinity based. In other words, some common interest, examples might include: parents of young children, blended families, immigrants or retirees. The affinities don’t always have to be so obvious. It could simply be that all the members of the group like each other.

Now what hasn’t changed. First, we have a lot of Neighborhood Small Groups that have been operating quite well. Those groups will continue. They are just now called Life Groups. All the groups will continue to be organized around the three themes: Believe, Belong, Bless. What does that mean? Every group should spend time in the study of God’s Word and applying it to daily life – Believe. The members of a small group should support one another in real concrete ways – Belong. Each small group should be a mission outpost sharing the Gospel in word and action to friends, neighbors and even strangers – Bless. It is our hope that each of these Life Groups will strengthen their group members to live a balanced Christian life (more on this in next month’s newsletter).

Another way of describing what should happen in our Life Groups is to use Jesus’ words and actions in the 13th Chapter of John. John records that Jesus washed his disciples’ feet as a demonstration of his love for them. He then said, *“A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.”*

The signup and kick-off for the new Life Groups will be on Rally Day, September 10, 2017. If you are not in a group I hope you will prayerfully consider signing up.

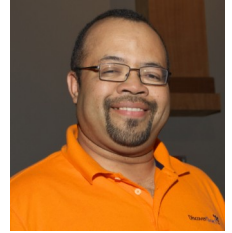
