# From Pastor Carl's Desk

## A GIDEON MOMENT

The following is a transcript from Pastor Carl's sermon on September 24, 2017

Last week, the Lord laid on my heart to prepare a special devotion and report for Council based on the vision and mission of Discover Church. After I was finished, the council urged me to share some version of that devotion and report with the congregation--not in an announcement but from the pulpit. Both Pastor La and I take our responsibility of bring the Word of God to you very seriously. The council's request required thought and prayer. After much thought and prayer, I agreed with the council that I needed to share what is on my heart as your senior leader. This week we are going to step out of the series on the 139<sup>th</sup> Psalm. Instead, we will talk about Gideon moments. Let's start by reading Scripture, Judges chapter seven, starting at verse two.

Judges 7:2 The Lord said to Gideon, "You have too many men. I cannot deliver Midian into their hands, or Israel would boast against me, 'My own strength has saved me.' 3 Now announce to the army, 'Anyone who trembles with fear may turn back and leave Mount Gilead.' " So twenty-two thousand men left, while ten thousand remained. 4 But the Lord said to Gideon. "There are still too many men. Take them down to the water, and I will thin them out for you there. If I say, 'This one shall go with you,' he shall go; but if I say, 'This one shall not go with you,' he shall not go." 5 So Gideon took the men down to the water. There the Lord told him, "Separate those who lap the water with their tongues as a dog laps from those who kneel down to drink." 6 Three hundred of them drank from cupped hands, lapping like dogs. All the rest got down on their knees to drink.

Let me tell you the rest of the story in my own words. After God had pared Gideon's army down to 300 men. He then tells Gideon to attack the Midianite camp. Gideon hesitates and God says, "if you are afraid to attack right away, go down to the Midianite camp with your servant and listen." Gideon gets within earshot of that camp and he hears two soldiers talking. One shares that he has had a strange dream that a barley cake has rolled into camp and upset the tent of the Midianite King. The other soldier interprets the dream and says that dream is about Gideon. He is going to defeat the Midianites. The conversation gives Gideon the courage to go back and summon his 300 men to take on the thousands upon thousands of the Midianites and Amalekites camped in the valley. Before Gideon summoned his 300, however, he worshiped. That is a Gideon moment.

What are the specifics of a Gideon moment? There are two criteria for a Gideon moment: first, you know that the Lord has given you a purpose, a mission. The second criteria is that there is no way you can accomplish that purpose/mission without the Lord. God had given Gideon a mission to defeat the Midianite army. At the same time, He wanted Gideon to understand that it was not Israel's strength nor strategy, but rather the Lord that was going to accomplish His will through Gideon and his three hundred warriors. The Lord said to Gideon, "The people with you are too many for me to give the Midianites into their hand, lest Israel boast over me, saying, 'My own hand has saved me.' Those moments are Gideon moments.

We have all had Gideon moments--times when God intervenes in our life in such a way that it is clear it is completely God, times that we realize God's grace and

power in our life. God has given us something that we are called to accomplish but it is God who provides the resources. We can't boast in our abilities; we can't brag about this or that strategy; we can't take credit in any way. All we can do, like Gideon, is worship and praise God. This is not new for many of you. You know about Gideon moments. You have experienced them time and again, even if that is not what you called them. In fact, I believe we could spend the next several hours having you come up and share Gideon moments in your life.

So why did we step out of our sermon series to talk about Gideon moments? Discover Church is at a Gideon moment. I truly believe that God has given us a clear vision, mission, and values. God has given us a clear vision--His vision that all people become believing, belonging and blessing followers of Jesus. Discover's Mission that we are called to invite all people to discover their full life in Christ is directly from the Lord God. It is **NOT** some clever thing thought up by Pastor La or myself, but a mission from God. I believe the same about our values-- that they are principles that form and define our culture. Finally, I believe that through our vision, mission and values God is doing something unique at Discover Church. Discover Church is becoming a church that reflects the vision of Revelation 7:9 "After this I looked, and there before me was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, tribe, people and language, standing before the throne and the Lamb."

This was confirmed to me just a couple Sundays ago. An acquaintance from the community visited our church. When the two of us were initially introduced last spring, I was introduced as one of the pastors of Discover Church. He responded, "I've heard good things about your church." As I said, that initial conversation was several months ago. He showed up this Sunday and said "God brought me to Discover Church instead of my own church." He went on to say that he wanted to experience Discover Church for himself. He made it very clear that he hadn't come looking for a new church home (he was very active in his home church) but rather simply to see what we were doing. After the service, he sought me out and waited patiently as I talked with several other individuals ahead of him. When he got his turn, he had two observation: First, that it was exciting to see the multi -ethnic makeup of our congregation. Secondly, that it was obvious that we invite people into the whole Gospel and not just a Gospel for when we die (those were his words, not mine). He concluded by saying, "God is doing something special at Discover Church." This conversation confirmed to me that God has given us our vision, mission and values. We have met criteria one for a Gideon moment: a mission and purpose given by God.

Let's move to criteria two: without the Lord's intervention, we will not be able to accomplish our mission. Again, that is very true. Our lack of resources have hindered us from completely fulfilling the mission God has given us. I am not going to go through all of the numbers. You can look on the back of the bulletin to get an idea. It's serious. Clever programs and ideas are not going to solve our lack of resources. Nor will drastic cuts or other drastic decisions solve the problem because anything of that nature will start a vicious circle that will prove difficult to stop and it will lead us in exactly the opposite direction. The leadership of this congregation and I agree we meet both criteria. We have a mission from God. There is no way we can accomplish that mission without God's intervention.

We are at a Gideon moment--a moment where we must depend on God. If God has provided the vision, then God will provide the resources. If God has given us this mission, then God will provide the resources. If our values that form who we are, are from God, then God will provide the resources.

I also believe that God wants to make it clear that when He provides those resources we will not be able to say, "It was our strategic planning, or our extra effort, or a great program." The only thing that we will be able to do is worship and praise. We are at a Gideon moment.

With that understanding, this is what I ask you to do. The council and leadership is designating the week of October 8<sup>th</sup> - 15<sup>th</sup>, a week of prayer and fasting for the mission of Discover Church. The specific prayer is that God will provide the resources for us to fulfill our mission. I want to ask each of you to join me in one of three ways: First to pray 3 times daily: when you get up in morning, at noon and at night. We will give you a devotional to help direct your prayer. Second, I want to ask you to fast in some way. It can be a full fast, for a day or the whole week. It can be a partial fast, skipping meals to pray for our mission. It can also be a Lenten type fast where we give up some special treat for the week. It doesn't even have to be food. It can be TV, social media or some other experience that you enjoy. The important thing is that you acknowledge the Lord God as your most important relationship, and that you value that relationship more than anything else.

Finally, on Wednesday Oct 11<sup>th</sup> we will have 24 hours of prayer, starting at 7am Wednesday and ending at 7am Thursday in the sanctuary. I encourage you sign up for at least one of those half hour time slots. Will you join me, the staff and the council in entreating the Lord to provide the resources so that we might fulfill our mission *inviting all people to discover their full life in Christ?*
